Dress Code: We are the representatives of our union on every job site, please wear appropriate work clothing, including the following:

- Closed toe shoes, preferably work boots or safety shoes
- Work gloves
- Weather appropriate gear (raingear, cold weather gear in winter – you may be outside pushing boxes and loading trucks)
- Full blacks for show calls

Tools: Specific, show-related tools are supplied by each touring production. However, each stagehand should carry the following personal tools:

- Flashlight or Headlamp
- Adjustable C-Wrench
- Multi-tool or pocket knife

Drugs, alcohol and violence will not be tolerated.

Please allow time for parking and check-in before call time starts. Common practice is to report to work 15 minutes early.
